before noon

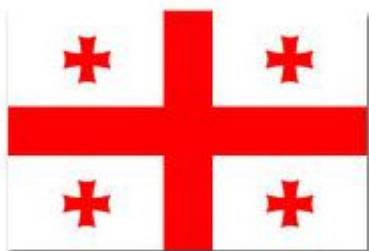
30 participants from 11 countries: 25 youth (16 - 18 yo) 5 staffies

The Camp site

Direction to the Camp site from Roissy airport

Your final destination is the **Train** (urban train) stop: **Meaux** (Paris East suburbs). We will wait for you there and take you to the campsite nearby.



→ From **Roissy airport** follow the sign « **Paris by train** » and take the line B of the **RER** (blue on the Parisian transports map) **direction "Robinson" ou "St-Rémy-les-Chevreuse"**. and stop to Gare du Nord



→ Take the Metro line 4 until Gare de l'Est
- Journey time around 1 hour
- Estimated price : 10 euros



→ From **GARE de l'EST (Paris subway station)** take the train to MEAUX (Château Thierry direction)
- Estimated price : 7,5 euros

Journey time around 1h30 mn

Direction to the Camp site from Orly airport



→ From **Orly** airport: take the **ORLYBUS** to **Denfert-Rochereau**

Estimated price : 7 euros



→ At Denfert-Rochereau take the Metro line 4 and stop at Gare de l'Est

Estimated Price : 2 euros



→ From **GARE de l'EST** take the train to MEAUX (Château Thierry direction)

Estimated price : 7,5 euros

Journey time around 1h30 mn
